From the Music Director....

One of the hymns for today is Savior of the Nations, Come. It has generated a huge repertoire of music. The Bells of Grace played a version of it today in the prelude. The text goes from the manger to the victory of the cross and resurrection. The resource I use for this article says the "Come" refers to Advent's paradox: Christ's first coming, second coming, and coming to us here and now.

There have been organ preludes and choral anthems composed on this title. The hymn can be attributed to Ambrose of Milan. (340-397) A very old hymn. Martin Luther was among those who translated it into German, probably for Advent 1523. Ambrose was rightly called the "father of church song" not because he was the first to do so but that so many have been found worth

keeping.

Offering Envelopes

There have been a number of questions regarding the changes to the offering envelopes. This change occurred to save the church money. Since there is no envelope number or date on the envelopes they can be used over a multi-year time period which saves having to purchase and throw away envelopes each year.

Any time you attend a service at church you can use an envelope from either the pack you picked up in November or by grabbing one from the narthexes or library.

We are requesting that on the envelopes the following fields are <u>always</u> completed: (see example below)

- ♦ Name or Envelope Number
- Date
- The dollar amount on the enclosed offering. Making sure to designate how much for each section and completing the Comment section if selecting Other or Special offering letting us know to what ministry you are contributing
- First time giving section if you have never given to the church in the past Since we now have the designations on the front of the envelope there is no need to write more than one check.

All of these changes also make it easier for the counters and staff to make sure that each person's contribution are properly designated.

Winter Overnight Shelter at Susquehanna Harbor Safe Haven

Once again the Winter Overnight Shelter for homeless men needs our help. Quite a few of our brothers and sisters at Grace have helped in past years and I am so grateful for that.

This winter we are committed to staff the week of February 16 to February 22, 2020. Two Volunteers are needed per night, one of whom must be male. The hours are 7:30 pm to 7:00 am. Paid staff are there to check the men in and this person stays until 10 pm, which is lights out for the guests.

All we have to do is make coffee, set out snacks, be available during the night, (you can go to sleep in a separate room), and get the guests out the door in the morning. Staff is available in the residential facility next door if needed.
