



#### From the Music Director....

The closing hymn for today is ELW 267, Joy to the World. It was not written for Advent or Christmas. It is the second half of a paraphrase of Psalm 98 by Issac Watts. In the Lutheran Book of Worship it stood as the first hymn of Christmas. In the ELW it is the last of the Advent hymns. It is logically on the cusp of two seasons. The heading that Watts gave was: "The Messiah's coming and Kingdom".

Issac Watts is known as the father of English hymnody. He argued for the singing of hymns instead of the Calvinist practice of singing only metrical psalms. He wrote over 600 hymns and psalm paraphrases. He decided to follow his father and enrolled at the Nonconformist academy at Stoke Newington. He became the senior minister at the Dissenting Mark Lane congregation in London.

The tune that is now most associated with the text is Antioch. It was joined with that text more than a century after Watts wrote it. Lowell Mason is attributed with the melody. Several other composers had their influence on the melody. Lowell Mason was directing a choir in Massachusetts by the time he was sixteen. He went to Savannah, Georgia as a bank clerk. He then taught music, organized singing schools. He also helped to compile The Boston Handel and Haydn Society Collection of Church Music in 1922. He also set up the Boston Academy of Music. He introduced music into the public school system. He spent his life trying to improve the church's musical life by teaching everyone to read music. Just a few thoughts on one of our more well known hymns sung at Advent and Christmas.
