
FROM THE TREASURER...

Their December meeting will spark meaningful budget discussions and speculation on what we may face as a society and congregation in 2021.

You can see from the Income and Expense chart that income still lags behind expenses. However, Advent and Christmas are upon us, and giving traditionally rises during this time. Thank you for your faithful contributions to our ministries. Please remember that Grace was granted a PPP loan for \$41,900 which is not reflected in the chart. The loan will help in light of our lower-than-expected income this year, and may even put us a little ahead by the time we close the year.


